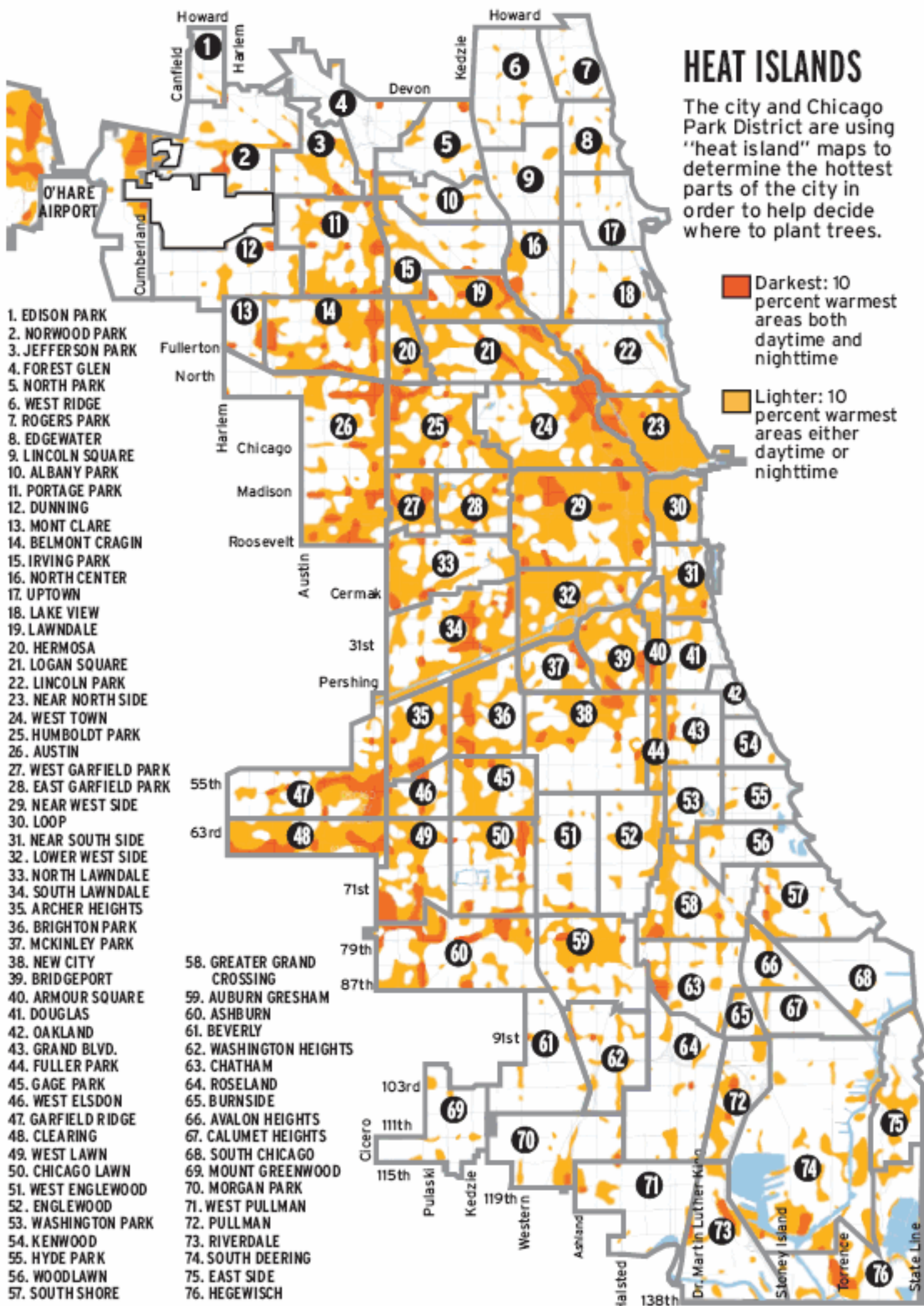


HEAT ISLANDS
